

1 Description

Series DDPSVA-1-10 ... safety pressure-relief cartridges are size 10 valves with a M30x1.5 screw-in thread. They are direct acting with a seated design and feature extremely low leakage. These safety valves comply with the Pressure Equipment Directive 2014/68/EU and are set at the required response pressure and security-sealed. The preferred response pressures are 330, 315 and 100 bar and CE typeapproved. Additional response pressures are available on application. These safety valves are typically used in hydraulic systems with pressure accumulators or pressure vessels. They safeguard the maximum allowable operating pressure by relieving oil from the protected line 1 to tank line 2. At Q_{max} (100 l/min), the back pressure in the tank line must not exceed 3 bar. All external parts of the cartridge are zinc-nickel plated to DIN 50 979 and are thus suitable for use in the harshest operating environments. If you intend to manufacture your own cavities, please refer to chapter 6 "cavity".



measured with oil viscosity 33 mm²/s (cSt)






1.) Response pressure p_A



We strongly recommend that pilot drilling, boring, reaming and cavity thread-cutting are performed in one setup.

IMPORTANT!

When fitting the cartridges, use the specified tightening torque and refer to the instruction manual.



ATTENTION!

Only qualified personnel with mechanical skills may carry out any maintenance work. Generally, the only work that should ever be undertaken is to check, and possibly replace, the seals. When changing seals, oil or grease the new seals thoroughly before fitting them.



IMPORTANT!

These safety pressure-relief cartridges are security-sealed in the factory. If the sealing wire is damaged, the safety of the cartridges can no longer be guaranteed.
